We are a charity set up in December 2023 to help the voluntary, community and social enterprise (VCSE) sector to access affordable premises whilst building strong communities where groups support one another and work together.

Our vision was to build a community of charities and social enterprises for people, place and planet under one roof in central Norwich, a shared space where we can share and grow our ideas, expertise, equipment and costs, while sustaining a building.

With the support of a passionate and experienced trustee team and in partnership with Norwich City Council, that dream slowly became reality. In October 2024, Norwich Unity Hub opened its doors in Carrow House. Once home to the Colman family, now reimagined as a home for collective community impact.

In less than a year, we've built more than just a workspace. We've nurtured a dynamic ecosystem of 26 organisations, 28 artists, and countless individuals, businesses and groups who use the space to run workshops, host events, collaborate on projects, and offer vital support services. We're breaking down silos and enabling real innovation, inclusion, and resource-sharing at a time when it's needed most.

Norwich Unity Hub isn't just a building. It's a movement rooted in trust, unity and action - one that's quietly reshaping the way community support works in Norfolk and beyond.

We believe this pioneering model of shared infrastructure and collaborative energy deserves to be recognised and celebrated. We've proved that when people come together under one roof with a shared vision, extraordinary things happen and we're just getting started.
